THE BERNARD FAMILY HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED FARMERS IN ORANGE SINCE THE MIDDLE OF THE 17TH CENTURY AND THE BEAUTIFUL CHATEAU FOLLOWED SEVERAL YEARS LATER. THE FAMILY'S GRENACHE, SYRAH AND MOURVEDRE VINES USED FOR THEIR CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE ARE OVER 100 YEARS OLD AND PRODUCE PERFECTLY CONCENTRATED, SPICY, RICH WINES.

ELEPHANT HILL SYRAH HAWKES BAY, NEW ZEALAND

RICH AND CONCENTRATED WITH BLACKBERRY, PLUMS, PEPPER AND SPICE, THIS WINE HAS A LONG FINISH AND VERY FINE GRAINED TANNINS. THIS WINE WILL CONTINUE TO IMPROVE AND (WITH PROPER CELLARING) CAN BE ENJOYED FOR TEN YEARS FROM VINTAGE. BEST SERVED WITH MEATY DISHES AND GAME.

BELEZOS RIOJA RESERVA BODEGAS ZUGOBER SPAIN

THIS RESERVA OFFERS A SUCCULENT ITERATION OF THIS CLASSIC RIOJA STYLE. WHILE RESPECTING TRADITIONAL STRUCTURE, THE WINE IS BURSTING WITH RIPE, DARK FRUIT BALANCED BY COMPLEX SAVOURY NOTES OF LEATHER AND TOBACCO. A LIGHT TOP NOTE OF VANILLA SPICE GIVES LIFT.

ERADUS PINOT NOIR MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

THE ERADUS FAMILY WINEMAKING PHILOSOPHY CENTRES ON ACHIEVING WINES WITH RIPENESS, BALANCE AND FRESHNESS. THIS PINOT NOIR BLENDS EARTHY MUSHROOM NOTES WITH DARK, PERFUMED FRUIT AND FLOWERS.

CHATEAU BEL-AIR CUVÉE MARGUERITE EIFFEL GRAVES DE VAYRES, BORDEAUX, FRANCE

A BLEND OF MERLOT, CABERNET FRANC, CABERNET SAUVIGNON AND MALBEC. FRESH MINT AND BRIGHT RASPBERRY FRUIT ON THE NOSE. THE PALATE IS COOL-FRUITED, WITH VIBRANT WILD STRAWBERRIES, SUPPLE TANNINS AND JUICY ACIDITY.

THE LANE SHIRAZ VIOGNIER ADELAIDE HILLS, AUSTRALIA

THE FRUIT OF THE LANE'S YOUNGER VINES, THIS WINE IS MADE BY CO-FERMENTING SHIRAZ WITH A DASH OF WHITE VIOGNIER GRAPES, LENDING A COMPLEXITY AND SOFTNESS TO THE WINE. DARK FRUIT AND WHITE PEPPER NOTES EMBELLISH.

MONTAPUCIANO D'ABRUZZA ROCCASTELLA ABRUZZO, ITALY

THE PRODUCER'S BELIEF IN THE LOCAL MONTAPUCIANO GRAPE AND TERROIR, TOGETHER WITH HELP FROM OENOLOGIST SIMONE SCHIAFINO, HAS RESULTED IN A PURE, EXPRESSIVE WINE WITH RIPE, DARK FRUIT AND A LINGERING SAVOURY SPICE.

BY THE GLASS:

FLOR DE CARDÓN' MALBEC, SALTA, ARGENTINA £9.8/£38.5

DARK IN COLOUR, WITH A SAVOURY NOSE EXUDING WILD DARK FRUIT WITH A FLORAL HINT. A SILKY MALBEC WITH A SEAMLESS TEXTURE, CARRYING CONCENTRATED FLAVOURS OF PUREED BLACKBERRIES, SAVOURY OLIVE NOTES AND LIGHT WOODY SPICES

ALTOS DE BAROJA RIOJA JOVEN SPAIN

THE VAILLONS HAS A PALE, BRIGHT GOLD COLOUR AND IS POWERFUL, RICH AND BALANCED ON THE PALATE. ITS FRUITY CHARACTER LEADS THE WAY TOWARDS A WONDERFULLY MINERAL FINISH.

POUILLY-FUMÉ LES CHAUMIERRES A&E FIGEAT CENTRAL LOIRE, FRANCE

ANDRÉ FIGEAT SEALED HIS FATE AS A VIGNERON WHEN HE FELL IN A VAT OF PRESSED JUICE AT AGE 2! NOW THE FAMILY WINEMAKER WITH STATE-OF-THE-ART EQUIPMENT, ANDRÉ SELECTS GRAPES FROM INDIVIDUAL SITES ACCORDING TO THEIR CHARACTER. FOSSIL-RICH, FLINTY SOIL GIVES THIS ZESTY, MINERAL POUILLY-FUMÉ ITS CHARACTERISTIC SMOKINESS.

THE LANE PINOT GRIS ADELAIDE HILLS, AUSTRALIA

THIS PINOT GRIS COMES FROM RISING STAR ADELAIDE HILLS ESTATE, THE LANE. FINE WHITE FLOWER AROMATICS AND PEACHES AND CREAM PALATE, BALANCED BY ATTRACTIVE MINERALLY ACIDITY.

PAZO LA MAZA ALBARINO ADEGAS GALEGAS DO RÍAS BAIXAS 2021, SPAIN

THIS ALBARIÑO PAYS HOMAGE TO ITS HOMETLAND – THE RÍAS BAIXAS REGION. LIVELY CITRUS, LIGHT BLOSSOM, RICH PEACH AND AN IRRESISTIBLE SALINE NOTE ON THE FINISH.

THE LANE BLOCK 1A CHARDONNAY ADELAIDE HILLS, AUSTRALIA

THE BLOCK 1A CHARDONNAY SHOWS LUSCIOUS, TROPICAL FRUIT AND TOASTED NOTES ON THE NOSE, WHILE REMAINING ELEGANT AND FRESH. THERE IS A PLEASING TEXTURE ON THE PALATE, WHICH OFFERS SMOOTH LAYERS OF RIPE, CREAMY STONE FRUIT BALANCED BY REFRESHING ACIDITY.

LOS CAMACHOS SAUVIGNON BLANC RESERVA VINEDOS MARCHIGUE CURICÓ VALLEY, CHILE

THIS IS AN ELEGANT AND DISTINCTIVE SAUVIGNON BLANC, GROWN AROUND THE BEAUTIFUL LAKE VICHUQUÉN IN THE REMOTE CURICÓ VALLEY. TROPICAL AND CITRUS NOTES BUT DELICATE TOO, ON THE GREEN SPECTRUM – THINK GUAVA, KIWI AND KEY LIME. ELEGANTLY TEXTURED ON THE PALATE.

BY THE GLASS:

HOMER SAUVIGNON BLANC ERADUS MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

ERADUS SAUVIGNON BLANC IS A DISTINCTIVE STYLE OF MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC WITH INTENSE FRUIT FLAVOURS AND AROMATIC DEPTH. THIS VIBRANT, AROMATIC WHITE WINE COMES FROM THE AWATERE VALLEY, SOUTH OF THE BETTER-KNOWN WAIRAU PLAINS, WHERE MICHIEL ERADUS (OWNER/WINEMAKER), BELIEVES THE PROLONGED RIPENING PERIOD HERE IS KEY TO THE WINES' FLAVOUR INTENSITY. THE ERADUS SAUVIGNON BLANC IS HERBACEOUS AND MINERAL WITH A LONG, RICH FINISH.

PASARI CHARDONNAY FETEASCA REGALA RECAS CRAMELE ROMANIA REGIONAL

A BLEND OF ROMANIA'S FLAGSHIP WHITE GRAPE – THE PERFUMED, SILKY FETEASCĂ REGALĂ, WITH THE RICH STONE FRUIT AND YELLOW GRAPEFRUIT OF CHARDONNAY. ON 24TH FEBRUARY EVERY YEAR, ROMANIANS CELEBRATE THE ARRIVAL OF SPRING WHEN BIRDS ('PĂSĂRI', IN ROMANIAN) BUILD THEIR NESTS, AND PEOPLE GATHER FOR FESTIVITIES DEDICATED TO LOVE AND NATURE.

LOWRY'S PASS CHENIN BLANC WEST CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA

LOWRY'S PASS IS MADE FROM VINEYARDS IN THE WESTERN CAPE, CLOSE TO THE HOTTENTOTS-HOLLAND MOUNTAIN RANGE. THE MOUNTAIN AIR AND COOLING BREEZES FROM THE NEARBY INDIAN OCEAN RESULTS IN A CRISP WINE WITH FRESH CITRUS FRUIT AND GREAT ACIDITY TO BALANCE.

PUERTOS ANTIGAS VIOGNIER CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE

MADE FROM A SPECIAL SELECTION OF GRAPES FROM THE PRODUCER'S BEST SITES IN THE VALLE CENTRAL, THIS WINE BURSTS WITH FLAVOURS OF STONE FRUIT OVER NOTES OF JASMINE AND HAZELNUTS, CULMINATING IN A FRESH, LONG FINISH.

ROSÉ

SOURCE GABRIEL ROSÉ COTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE

THIS IS CLASSIC PROVENCE ROSÉ. SO PALE AND DELICATE, YET FRUITY. A REAL CROWD-PLEASER. FLORAL NOTES COUPLED WITH THAT KIND OF RICH STONE FRUIT YOU ONLY GET FROM WINES FROM THIS PART OF FRANCE. A SUMMER STAPLE

DOMAINE DE MONTAUBERON GRENACHE/SYRAH ROSE COTES DE THONGUE, FRANCE

ONCE A ROYAL ESTATE, DOMAINE DE MONTAUBERON WAS BOUGHT BY THE ANCESTORS OF CURRENT OWNER PHILIPPE DE BERTIER 13 GENERATIONS AGO. PHILIPPE'S ROSÉ IS A REFRESHING BLEND OF GRENACHE AND SYRAH WITH VIBRANT RASPBERRY FLAVOURS AND DELICATE NOTES OF WHITE BLOSSOM.
